The Access Project is committed to safeguarding and promoting the welfare of children and expects all staff and volunteers to share this commitment.

These guidelines outline TAP's suggestions for student/tutor contact once a pairing's tutorials with The Access Project have finished.

Once a pairing ends, the student should not be contacting their tutor, and vice-versa. It's important for this reason that all tutors confirm with their University Access Officer the date of their final tutorial.

However, we do encourage Year 11 and 13 students to contact their tutors after the August Results Day each year: the majority of tutorials will have been focused on the knowledge and preparation required for these exams and therefore it is important to encourage students to provide feedback to tutors.

Whilst we cannot prevent other forms of text or email contact, University Access Officers will be reminding students not to continue contacting tutors and we strongly encourage tutors to adhere to these guidelines.
