The Access Project is committed to ensuring the safety and wellbeing of all children taking part in our activities.

Given on-going public concern on the subject of child abuse we are required to report if we think any child has come to harm as a consequence of possible abuse.

The Access Project has a Designated Child Protection Officer and Deputy Designated Child Protection Officer appointed to be responsible for Child Protection matters and specially trained for the task.
